4th round: the fences were 1.10cm which Cecilia bravely jumped both clear. 5th round - parallel & upright were 1.20cm only Rose Whisker managed to jump both fences. Christmas PC Show Results

Flamstead PC held their annual indoor SJ show at Patchetts EQ on Thursday 29th Dec. HHPC had members competing in all the classes. Novice 75 - 80cms Kirsty Higgins new pony had faults in the first round. Rosie Atkins, Cecilia Price, Lauren Smith & Louise Hunt made up the team, they all jumped really well, with some fast times in the jump off & came 3rd in the team section, with Lauren & Wotti getting 2nd place as an individual.

The Dengie course was full up & had a really scary double – two uprights fences against the wall with wooden cartwheels as fillers in both parts! This caused the most problems in the course, with both horses & ponies either refusing to go near the 1st part or running out of the 2nd fence.

Vicky Smith & Bryan jumped an amazing double clear round & went on to get 7th place in the Dengie – giving them a qualification to the Area Regional finals in March at Addington Manor. Brilliant news.

We had a 3 rider team in the intermediate class (1m): Emma Chambers, Lily Hubbard & Beccy Reeves. They came 3rd as a team & Beccy was 5th as an individual. They all jumped again in the Open class (1.05 – 1.10m). Again coming 3rd as team & Beccy & Bertie came 2nd as an individual.

Seb Weston & Tilly jumped in the 45cm & 60cm class with a few faults in each class. Well done to the boys. Rosie Atkins & Isabelle Hoar jumped in the 60cm & 75 cm classes – just having 4 faults each. Liberty Fogden jumped in Dengie & 1m class. Emma killin & Dougal jumped two brilliant rounds in their first Dengie class & came 4th. 
