Dengie SJ & Dressage Winter Qualifiers

At short summery on the rules for The Dengie competition is a winter series of qualifiers for SJ & dressage. there are two level for both.

More info on PC website.

<u>SJ – Novice Preliminary</u> rounds are open to riders & horse or pony combinations who have <u>not</u> represented their branches at Open Area qualifiers or the PC Championships for Show Jumping or the PC show jumping finals at Hickstead. JA ponies or Grade A & B horses registered with BSJA in the current year or previous year are not eligible.

The course heights are max 90cms.

The Open dengie SJ qualifiers: open to all members & associates of the pony club.

Course heights are max 1.10m

<u>Dressage Novice qualifiers rules</u>; open to riders & pony or horse combinations that have not represented their branches at intermediate or Open Area dressage competitions or have competed at the PC championships at intermediate or Open dressage. riders must not have won any BD points or competed at BD Novice level or above. Horses or ponies maybe graded British dressage Novice level or below.

Preliminary rounds: PC Novice dressage test 2009.

Dressage Open qualifiers; open to all members & associates. Horses or ponies which have competed at Advanced Medium level or above during the current year are not eligible. Including Hors Concours.

Preliminary rounds: PC intermediate dressage test 2009. Both tests can be found on Competition dates for both dressage & SJ, plus the dressage tests can be found on The Pony Club website: www.pcuk.org under disciplines. Look for winter League Dengie competitions.

MKEC is holding some Novice SJ classes at their indoor shows during the winter. Otherwise you will find dates in the different Areas. We are Area 12.

Areas around Area 12 are: Area 6 to N, Area 7 to NW, Area 9 to W, Area 13 to S & Area 8 to E.

The dressage competitions are much harder to find. The next one in our Area is OBH North PC in February half term at Bury Farm.

Lauren Smith & Millie Dickinson came 2nd in the pairs.


