## Half Term is looking very Busy!!!

**OBH Chilterns** have a indoor show jumping on Tuesday 27<sup>th</sup> Oct at Patchetts EQ, Watford. This includes a Dengie SJ Q.



Whaddon Chase PC has an open show at Addington on Wednesday 28<sup>th</sup> Oct. There are SJ & dressage classes for most levels including dengie Q, in both the SJ & dressage.

Both shows will get very full quickly, so it's worth entering early – both schedules are on www.hertshunt.com.

Anyone wanting to go to either competition & would like to be part of a team in the classes which have team sections, please text / email Janeen to let her know you have entered.

Cross Country instruction on Thursday 29<sup>th</sup> Oct for the 11yrs & under riders is at Plum Park Farm. This is a nice course with fences in a field & then there is a wide stream with a slope into & out. This is a good introduction to water for ponies & riders. It is worth taking a set of clothes & a towel – just in case water is too appealing !!

Shire Lane Farm cross country course is just outside Cholesbury. This is another nice course not to hilly, with jumps in & out of the woods, a combination in a dip & a small water jump which always causes a lot of problems at competitions! We haven't hired this course for many years. So we thought it would be good to go again. Linda Rogers who owns Shire lane farm will be the instructor.

Knots Achievement Badge on Friday 30<sup>th</sup> Oct is for members 8 yrs old & over, please bring a head collar lead rope & a tie, to practice with.

Also on Friday 30<sup>th</sup> Oct Janeen has organised 3 hours of indoor jumping instruction at Patchetts EQ, Watford. There will be limited spaces & depending who goes will depend on heights jumped.

Event Planner: There is a list of dates for the various test levels on the Event Planner. There is also a list of names of the test groups.



Please try & go to the training as it is always beneficial to learn about horse & pony care.

#### Pony Club Efficiency Tests

The pony club training structure encourages members to take tests which enables them to learn progressively about horse & pony care & improve their riding abilities.

**E standard:** Voluntary test for younger riders. Objective is to improve & enjoy learning about ponies. To know basic points of the pony. Riding: sit on a pony in halt & walk. Hold the reins correctly. Ride at trot on a lead rein & stop.

**D Standard**: Learning the basic understanding of ponies, achieving confidence when handling & riding. Recommended age 8 -9yrs **D+ standard**: Objectives is to work towards improving a balanced seat independent of the reins, so understanding the basic aids. Recommended age 10yrs.

C standard: Objectives are to understand the importance of a secure seat,

(C standard) independent of the reins & apply simple aids correctly. To know how to care & work a pony off grass. To have a regard for the country lore. Minimum age 11 – 12 yrs. C+ standard: To become an educated & practical horse rider, to ride over fences at all paces. To be capable of riding a pony out hunting and at all types of rallies. To have practical experience & knowledge of the care both for stabled & grass kept ponies. Minimum age 14 yrs.

**B standard:** To have in depth knowledge of horse & pony care.

**B standard – Riding**: To become an effective rider who knows the reasons for what he/she is doing. Able to ride in a double bridle. Different horses. To ride over fences at all paces. Be capable of riding out hunting, in competitions ie: show jumping, horse trials etc. Recommended age 15 /16 yrs & above.

## Important Message from Branch Secretary

The committee have to plan & book our rallies & activities about 3 months in advance to get venue dates & the instructors of our choice. To help parents plan their diary dates, we now



issue the Event Planner in 3 month blocks. Also this should help on the financial side as payments required cover a shorter periods. We can

accept post dated cheques. This helps those families with more than one member. This option is also available to everyone.

Please can I ask all parents to book their daughters / sons on to events via the event planner only & not directly with organiser. Printable copies are always on www.hertshunt.com

The more notice you can give the better the groups can be planned with instructors & venues. If you want to attend at short notice – please contact me as well as the organiser. Your name must be on my list before any rally / activity for insurance & safety reasons. A cheque needs to be sent preferably before attending, or immediately afterwards. Otherwise you accumulate scary debts.

#### Area Competition Success

Herts Hunt PC members have really excelled this year at Area competitions, all that training through the winter & spring must have paid off!!

We had 14 members qualify for both PC Championships this summer Having had so many members going forward to the Championships, meant headache trying to keep all the horses / ponies fit & well before



the big day. . Intermediate & Open PC Championships at Draycott Manor, just outside Derby: Katie Bennitt & Roo did very well in the Open dressage with a  $2^{nd}$ place in her arena & finishing with a 7<sup>th</sup> place in the final ride

off test. Steph Gibbins & Apollo jumped clear in the 1<sup>st</sup> round & only had 8 faults in the second round of the intermediate class.

Olivia's horse – Moggie suddenly got an abscess on one of his back teeth, which mean the whole side of his face swelled up. Sadly they weren't able to go to the horse Trials Championship. The course was like a mini Badminton with lots of decorations on or around the fences, including park benches with a teddy bear's picnic & indian tepee tents & covered wagon fence!.

We also had a **polocrosse team** competing at these Championships for the second year running. They did very well & won the Malden Cup, our Team was Harriet Price, Debbie Daniels, Abbie Ward, Pheobe Ward, Ellie Mitchell & who was a centre member.

We had a bit of a fraught week leading up to the Novice horse trials Champs with Sarah's horse Alfie getting kicked badly in the field on the Tuesday before.
